Timothy S. Bitsberger served at Freddie Mac as senior vice president and treasurer, Funding and Investor Relations from 2006 through December 2008. In this capacity, he was responsible for the company's debt and mortgage funding program, as well as debt and mortgage securities investor relations.

Prior to joining Freddie Mac, Mr. Bitsberger served as assistant secretary for financial markets at the U.S. Department of the Treasury from 2004 to 2005. In this presidentially-appointed post requiring U.S. Senate confirmation, Mr. Bitsberger led the Office of Financial Markets. Under his leadership, improvements in debt management and increased transparency resulted in enhanced relationships with all global market participants.

Accomplishments include expansion of the TIPS program, a new auction system and the reintroduction of the 30-year bond.

Previously, he served as deputy assistant secretary for federal finance at the U.S. Treasury from 2001-2003 years, providing policy recommendations on federal financial market issues and assessing the impact of those policies on industries and markets.

Prior to his Treasury appointments, Bitsberger worked on Wall Street for more than 15 years primarily as a trading manager and fixed-income and derivative trader.,

He is on the Board of Directors of the CME group. He graduated from Yale University with a BA in economics in 1981 and Harvard Business School in 1985.
