Pat A. Robinson is an Assistant General Counsel in the Legal Division of the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System. She manages the Legal Division's evaluation of merger and acquisition applications subject to Federal Reserve Board review under the Bank Holding Company Act, Bank Merger Act, Change in Control Act, or Federal Reserve Act, and other applications filed under these statutes. She has held this official position since January 2005.
